



AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TRUSTEES AND TEACHER

1. The Board of Trustees of the ... No. ... of the Province of Alberta hereby agrees to employ ... who has taught in the said Province ... years and ... months and who holds a ... Class Certificate of qualification, being No. ... issued by the ... (From School, 11111) Department of Education for the Province of Alberta, as Teacher in the said School District, from and after the ... day of ... 192...

2. The salary to be paid said Teacher shall be at the rate of ... dollars per year, such salary to be increased annually as follows:

3. The said Board further binds and obliges itself and its successors in office to pay the said Teacher during the continuance of this Agreement the sum or sums for which it hereby becomes bound in accordance with the provisions of The School Act.

The salary earned shall be estimated as provided in Section 199 of The School Act, which is in part as follows:

"The salary of a Teacher shall be estimated by dividing the rate of salary for the year by 200 and multiplying the result obtained by the number of actual teaching days within the period of his engagement;

"Provided that if the salary stated in the Teacher's contract is given at a monthly rate, the rate of salary for the year shall be deemed to be an equivalent to twelve times the said monthly rate."

4. The said Teacher hereby agrees with the said Board and its successors in office and binds ... self to teach and conduct the school of the said District according to the provisions of The School Act and the regulations of the Department of Education.

5. The vacation periods shall be in accordance with the provisions of The School Act, Sections 182 and 183. The summer vacation shall extend for a period of ... weeks from and after ...

6. This agreement shall continue in force from year to year, unless it is terminated as hereinafter provided, or unless the Certificate of the Teacher has been revoked in the meantime.

Either party hereto may terminate the agreement by giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing to the other party:

Provided that no such notice shall be given by the Board until the Teacher has been given the privilege of attending a meeting of the Board (of which five clear days' notice in writing shall be given to the Teacher) to hear and to discuss its reasons for proposing to terminate the agreement.

AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

TRUSTEES AND TEACHER

1. The Board of Trustees of the Peace River No. 2205 of the Province of Alberta hereby agrees to employ F. H. de la Savoye who has taught in the said Province 1 years and 11 months and who holds a 2nd Class Certificate of qualification, being No. 2 issued by the Department of Education for the Province of Alberta, as Teacher in the said School District, from and after the 4th day of September 1928.

2. The salary to be paid said Teacher shall be at the rate of thirteen hundred dollars per year, such salary to be increased annually as follows:

3. The said Board further binds and obliges itself and its successors in office to pay the said Teacher during the continuance of this Agreement the sum or sums for which it hereby becomes bound in accordance with the provisions of *The School Act*.

The salary earned shall be estimated as provided in Section 190 of *The School Act*, which is in part as follows:--

"The salary of a Teacher shall be estimated by dividing the rate of salary for the year by 260 and multiplying the result obtained by the number of actual teaching days within the period of his engagement."

"Provided that if the salary stated in the Teacher's contract is given at a monthly rate, the rate of salary for the year shall be deemed to be a sum equal to twelve times the said monthly rate."

4. The said Teacher hereby agrees with the said Board and its successors in office and binds himself to teach and conduct the school at the said District according to the provisions of *The School Act* and the regulations of the Department of Education.

5. The vacation periods shall be in accordance with the provisions of *The School Act*, Sections 182 and 183.

The summer vacation shall extend for a period of 8 weeks from and after the 1st of September.

6. This agreement shall continue in force from year to year, unless it is terminated as hereinafter provided, or unless the Certificate of the Teacher has been revoked in the meantime.

Either party hereto may terminate the agreement by giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing to the other party:

Provided that no such notice shall be given by the Board until the Teacher has been given the privilege of attending a meeting of the Board (of which five clear days' notice in writing shall be given to the Teacher) a hour and to discuss its reasons for proposing to terminate the agreement.

7. Other provisions mutually agreed upon:

8. All amendments to this agreement are subject to the provisions of *The School Act* and to the approval of the Minister of Education.
